- 6. You want \$500 for Christmas presents and already saved \$185, if you only have 7 weeks left, how much would you have to put aside each week to make up the difference?
- 7. You earn 1.5 vacation days per month and worked 10 months. If you have taken 3 vacation days, how many days are left?
- 8. There are 95 people in the room, 15 women and 27 of the men were smoking. How many people were not smoking?
- 9. You bought 6 cans of soup at 30 cents apiece and 4 loaves of bread at 65 cents apiece. How much over \$4 is the total cost?
